TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

YOU DO NOT HAVE TO BELONG TO A SENIOR LEAGUE TO ENTER

1. All entrants must be members of USBC and the CT State USBC Association with a current 2024-2025 Membership card (USBC RULE 300c) or have a current 2024-2025 USBC membership receipt.
2. Please note new age requirement as per USBC. **All entrants shall be at least 50 years of age as of JULY 1, 2025. Age as of JULY 1, 2025 shall determine the age group she will participate in at both the State and National Tournament.**
3. **Participants may enter up to two (2) times, but can cash only once.**
4. Entrant shall use her highest USBC CERTIFIED AVERAGE of at least 21 games for the 2023-2024 winter season. If an entrant does not have a previous winter league average, the following will be used in descending order:
 - A. Highest average of at least 21 games for 2022-2023 winter season.
 - B. Highest average of at least 21 games for 2024 summer season.
 - C. Bowlers with Challenge/Sport League averages will have their average adjusted per USBC chart (Rules 201a-c).
 - D. If no verifiable average, the bowler would then bowl scratch.USBC Rule 319a.2 (10-pin increase provision) shall **not** apply. USBC Rule 319d (prize money reporting) shall **not** apply. USBC Rule 319e (average adjustment) shall **not** apply.
However, USBC Rule 319a.3 (average verification) will apply and USBC Rule 319c (average re-rating) will apply.
5. The tournament shall consist of 6 games, bowled in two (2) three game blocks. All 6 games may be bowled on the same day or 3 games on one day and 3 games on another day.
6. Entrant shall report 45 minutes before scheduled time to bowl and may be requested to present her membership card or temporary membership receipt.
7. Handicap shall be 100% of the difference between the entrant's average and 225. Those with a 225 average or over will bowl scratch.
8. A bowler arriving late may bowl but her score shall begin in the frame being bowled with zero for the frames missed.
9. In the event the bowler cannot finish her series, zero pins shall be scored in all remaining frames.
10. The winner in each division shall be determined by the highest pinfall with handicap based on a six (6) game total and will be the only one eligible to attend the National USBC Senior Championships Women's Division. If first place is unable to attend, this opportunity will be offered to the second place bowler in that division. The CT State USBC Association will pay the entry fee for the winner in each age group. Should the first place winner fail to attend the Senior National Championship without prior notification to the Connecticut State USBC Association, the entrant will be responsible for all fees paid by the Association.
11. Cash prizes shall be awarded on a handicap basis, at least 1 for every 5 entries. A State Association award shall be presented to the winner in each age group on a handicap basis. Prize fees collected for each class shall be returned 100%.
12. In the event of ties for 1st place, duplicate awards shall be given and co-champions declared. A one game roll-off with handicap between those tied for 1st place will determine the entrant who will represent CT at the National USBC Senior Championships Women's Division Tournament. Prize money for ties shall be combined and equally divided.
13. Any problem not governed by the rules stated above or on the face of the entry form will be governed by USBC rules. Any protest shall comply with USBC Rule 329.
14. Checks in payment of money prizes shall be mailed within 30 days after the close of the tournament, except when the USBC has authorized delay of payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest, which affects position standings.
15. **Participants are not allowed to smoke during competition.**
16. **No refund of entry fee will be made after entry has been processed and squad time assigned.** Prior to the start of competition, a substitute/replacement will be allowed for the entire six (6) games. Entry fee must accompany entry form. All checks should be made payable to: **CT State USBCA**. (Returned checks and fees must be paid in cash, bank check, or money order prior to bowling.)
17. **ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN THE FIRST POST OFFICE BUSINESS DAY AFTER OCTOBER 16, 2024.**
18. The entrant whose name appears on the entry form agrees that CT State USBC Association, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning the entry fee if and when the entrant shall have been prevented from bowling in the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or causes relating thereto or resulting from fire, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the CT State USBC Association.
