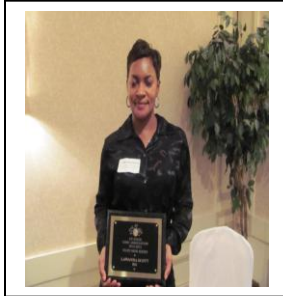
One Bowler Scores New CTUSBC High Series and Another Ties Own High Record

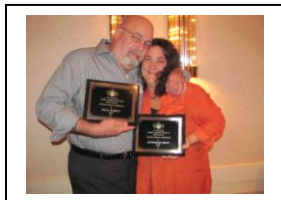
